

Maths

This term, Redwood Class will be focusing on number. This includes looking deeply at place value and really understanding what numbers mean and represent. This will allow the children to have a stronger understanding when looking at the four operations of number: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Inquiry

We will be splitting this term into two halves. The first half term we will be looking to answer the question, 'How vicious were the Vikings?' as we learn about their invasions and battles. After half term, however, we will focus more on where the Vikings came from and learn all about Scandinavia. We will study the similarities and differences between life in Britain and life in modern day Norway, Denmark and Sweden.

English

In English, we are beginning Talk For Writing which is very exciting. This new way of teaching English will mean that over the autumn term the children will write 2 fiction and 2 non-fiction pieces where the children will be working towards their own individual composition targets. We will be looking at the story of Beowulf, writing instructions and a persuasive text.

PE

We will be learning the team sport of Hockey this term and focusing on Gymnastics and Dance.
