In our Inquiry work, we will be finding out about The Romans: where the empire was in the world; when The Romans ruled; its cultural importance and the beginnings of democracy.



RE
In RE, through our inquiry approach, we will return to Hinduism and investigate the question 'How can Brahman be in everything and everywhere?'



ART and DT
We will use The Romans as inspiration for our art work this term. Studying mosaics and investigating how art and architecture were utilised to create a more civilised society.



PSHE
As citizens, we will be examining our place in the world. We will set up our class charter, understanding our roles and responsibilities. We will also investigate our rights and responsibilities within the wider school community.

PE

English
We will be implementing our Talk 4 Writing programme, practising our story writing and instruction writing. We will also continue to learn and identify grammatical terms and to practice our handwriting. We will enjoy story time and continue to grow our independence in reading.

COMPUTING



We will create powerful presentations with the use of Powerpoint. In the final half of the term, we will continue with our investigation of coding.

SCIENCE

As scientists, 'Animals, including humans' is our topic. We will study the stages of life and reproduction in different species of animals.

OUTDOOR CLASSROOM

For the first half-term, Mrs Wands will take our Year 5/6 topics and create practical lessons outside.

MATHS

As mathematicians, we will revise all the topics we have learnt so far this year. We will continue to learn mathematical vocabulary and revisit the relationship between decimals, percentages and fractions. We will continue to develop methods for all 4 number operations, and use these to solve real-life problems. In geometry, we will revise the properties of shape. We will continue to convert between different measurements. We will, also, learn to use algebra, learning how to find the nth term in Year 6. Whilst we gather all this knowledge, we will learn to explain our understanding through reasoning and apply this information to problem solve.



FRENCH

As linguists, we will explore French culture culture, whilst learning how to greet others and to introduce ourselves.



MUSIC

As performers, we will practise and stage our KS2 production.
